

RONDA CARTER

Ronda and her Border Collies have won too many awards to name. ADCH MACH 2 Scout has been a USDAA Grand Prix finalist 5 times and has the USDAA Lifetime Achievement Award (gold level). She was the 22" International champion at the 2004 IFCS World Championships, and the winner of the 2005 USDAA Veteran's Grand Prix at 22". ADCH MACH Blast has completed the USDAA Lifetime Achievement Award (Bronze level) and, at the 2006 IFCS/USDAA World Championships, won 5 gold medals and was crowned world champion in biathlon and team. Blast won the USDAA National 22" Grand Prix and the DAM title here in Scottsdale in 2006, and has won 3 USDAA Regional Grand Prix'. Her two young dogs, Pyro and Potion, are just starting to compete.

SEMINAR 1 - ADVANCED HANDLING - October 22-24, 2008 - 3 days of working with Ronda on improving and polishing your handling skills. This is a great warm-up for the USDAA Championships. For dogs working at the Masters, Excellent, or Elite levels, or participating in the USDAA Championships.

SEMINAR 2 - INDEPENDENT OBSTACLE PERFORMANCE - November 4-5, 2008 - If you have watched Ronda run her dogs (like at the USDAA Nationals), you will see that she is a master at leaving the dog performing an obstacle and moving on to the next handling position. Come learn her secrets.

SEMINAR 3 - INTERMEDIATE HANDLING - November 6, 2008 - An intensive 1 day seminar for those getting ready to compete, or competing at a Novice or Open/Advanced level.

Ronda will also be doing private lessons on Monday (all day) and Tuesday morning, October 27 & 28, 2008, 1 hour lessons for 1, 2, 3 or 4 participants.
