

SUMMER FUN RUN SCHEDULE

As usual, JCAC will be hosting Summer Fun Runs this summer at the Cholla Patch (17th Ave. just north of Happy Valley Rd., directions on the JCAC website under Classes), on Tuesday nights, as well as some "mini seminars" on Thursday nights. Unless noted otherwise below, the Summer Fun Runs start at 7:15 p.m. and end about 9:30 p.m. or whenever everyone has run twice (could be more if time warrants). Also, we will run 2 rings simultaneously, with the events the same for the Advanced and Novice unless noted below, although, of course, the courses are harder for Advanced. Also, the Novice classes include instruction on how to run each event, and on the rules and strategies; for the advanced class, the students are presumed to know the rules.

Some Tuesday nights, the Novice course will be a different event than the Advanced course. If your dog is experienced enough to run the Advanced course, you may run each course once, or one of the courses twice. If there is time, you may be able to run one of the courses again, but this will depend upon attendance. If you are just running in one of the rings, you may run that course twice (the third run will again depend upon time).

You can come for some of the Fun Runs, or all of the Fun Runs. If you desire, you can pay for all 10 Tuesday nights at a discount rate. The cost is as follows: \$8 per night per dog for Jumping Chollas members, \$10 per night per dog for non-members (instructors run free). If you pay for all the nights on the first night, the summer package price is \$60 for members, \$80 for non-members.

The Thursday night mini-seminars will start at 7:00 p.m. and go to about 9:30 p.m. Price will be \$10 per dog per mini-seminar. These seminars are open to all JCAC students who have completed at least the Foundation class, unless otherwise noted.

Also, these fun runs are for JCAC students only. Admission for non JCAC students will be determined on a case by case basis, primarily depending upon space/parking availability. Here is the tentative JCAC summer schedule (subject to change):

6/11/09 Mini-seminar (Thursday) - Distance work. This seminar will focus on some of the exercises from Sharon Nelson's distance seminars and possibly some other distance work. Dog must have at

least completed JCAC Beginner I class.

6/23/09 Fun Run #1 (Tuesday) - Touch N Go in Advanced ring/
Jumpers in Novice ring.

6/25/09 Mini-seminar (Thursday)- Weave poles / Hoopers. We will do some weave pole drills at this seminar for dogs who are having trouble weaving, or finding entrances to the weaves. On the other side of the field, we will set up a Hoopers course.

6/30/09 Fun Run #2 (Tuesday) - FAST courses (NOTE - FAST is the AKC class which features a distance challenge)

7/7/09 Fun Run #3 (Tuesday) - Jumpers in Advanced ring/ Tunnelers in Novice ring

7/14/09 Fun Run #4 (Tuesday) - Weavers in Advanced ring/ Jumpers with Weaves in Novice ring

7/21/09 Fun Run #5 (Tuesday) - Chances courses

7/28/09 Fun Run #6 (Tuesday) - Jumpers with Weaves in Advanced ring/Touch N Go in Novice ring

8/4/09 Fun Run #7 (Tuesday) - Snooker courses

8/6/09 Mini-seminar (Thursday) - Front and rear crosses. This mini-seminar will focus on practicing front crosses and rear crosses. Open to all students who have completed the Beginner II class.

8/11/09 Fun Run #8 (Tuesday) - Gamblers courses

8/18/09 Fun Run #9 (Tuesday) - Jumpers with Weaves in Advanced class/ Tunnelers in Novice Class

8/20/09 Mini-seminar (Thursday) - Distance work. This mini-seminar will focus on working distance, both basic skills and practicing some more advanced distance exercises. Dog must have at least completed JCAC Beginner I class.

8/25/09 Fun Run #10 (Tuesday) - FAST course in Advanced ring/Hoopers course in Novice ring

9/3/09 Mini-seminar (Thursday) - How to walk and analyze a course. This seminar will focus on how to walk a course and how to analyze a course for best results.

During the month of September, JCAC will host Nationals Practice at the Chollas Patch, open to any dog (whether training with JCAC or not) who is attending and participating in one of the upcoming National Championships - NADAC, ASCA, AKC Invitational, USDAA.
