AWARDS

First through Fourth place rosettes will be awarded in each class for each height division for qualifying scores. Qualifying ribbons will also be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores. Double Q ribbons, beautiful MACH poles and MACH ribbons will also be awarded to those who earn them. We will use NCR sheets.

Both clubs will also be awarding rosettes for **new titles**.

All awards must be collected during the show. None will be held over or mailed. Awards will not be available until judges have reviewed the appropriate scribe sheets.

Non-Regular Class International Class

The International Sweepstake Class (ISC) is a non-regular class providing a dog and handler an opportunity to demonstrate their advanced training and handling skills on various international style Standard and Jumpers With Weaves courses. This class is open only to dogs that are eligible to compete in both the Excellent Standard Class and the excellent Jumpers With Weaves Class, Regular or Preferred.

Height Divisions

Mini Agility	13.75" or less at withers	Jump 14"
Midi Agility	16.88" or less at withers	Jump 18"
Maxi Agility	Greater than 16.88" at withers	Jump 26"

NOTE:ISC combined Class winners will be invited to attend the World Team Tryouts in Hopkins, Minnesota. Only Clean Run scores will be used to compute the Combined Score winners. The winners will be from the 14", 18" and 26" height classes. The dog must have an approved pedigree and also fulfill any requirements for the specific Rabies shots or titrating to attend Tryouts. The handler at Tryouts must be the same handler that won the combined award at this trial. Further information maybe found at www.akc.org.

OBSTACLES

Obstacles will conform to current requirements of the Agility Rules and Regulations. Some of the contact equipment has a rubberized-coated surface in accordance with AKC specifications. Weave poles will have 24" spacing. Electronic timing will be used in all rings.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

The following jump height divisions shall be used in all Titling trial classes:

- 8 inches**..... For dogs 11 inches and under at the withers
- 12 inches**..... For dogs 14 inches and under at the withers
- 16 inches**..... For dogs 18 inches and under at the withers
- 20 inches**..... For dogs 22 inches and under at the withers
- 24 inches**..... For dogs over 22 inches at the withers
- 26 inches**..... Dogs may be entered at this height at their owner's discretion

The following jump height divisions shall be used in all Preferred Titling trial classes:

- 4 inches**..... For dogs 11 inches and under at the withers
- 8 inches**..... For dogs 14 inches and under at the withers
- 12 inches**..... For dogs 18 inches and under at the withers
- 16 inches**..... For dogs 22 inches and under at the withers
- 20 inches**..... For dogs over 22 inches at the withers

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk their course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. The walk-through allows handlers to plan their strategy for running the course. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class.

There will be no course familiarization for novice handlers at this trial

A warm-up area, consisting of one regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors. Exhibitors may **NOT** use the warm-up area to relieve their dogs.

Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

RING INFORMATION

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. This trial will be held in 3 rings at least 100 feet by 100 feet in diameter. All rings will run simultaneously. Exhibitors **should be prepared to have walked more than one course**. Exhibitors with potential conflicts **must** inform the gate steward **BEFORE** the class starts. Excellent will walk by jump height to the extent possible. Except in EXTRAORDINARY circumstances, there will be no additional walk-throughs. A conflict is viewed as when either the handler has to be in another ring with the same or a different one of "their" dogs or the dog has to be in another ring. It is the **gate steward's discretion** where the dog will be placed in the running order. Wanting to see someone else run another one of your dogs in a different event does not constitute a conflict. The clubs hosting the trial and the Trial Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service, runners or public address systems for the purpose of locating or calling dogs that are not brought to the ringside when required.

This trial will be held outside on grass, regardless of weather. There is limited shade available. Confirmation, rally and obedience are offered through Jack Bradshaw and judged at WestWorld of Scottsdale.

ELIGIBILITY OF DOGS

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC or PAL/ILP number

Dogs of a registerable breed with an acceptable foreign registration number are eligible to participate subject to Chapter 11, Section 1 of the Dog Show Rules.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible. Bitches in season shall not be eligible to

participate.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

The trial will be conducted under American Kennel Club *Regulations for Agility Trials*. For copies of the Regulations, write to The American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Suite 100, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390 or call (919) 233-9767. Also can be printed directly from the Internet - <http://www.akc.org/agregs.htm>.

Entries must reach the Trial Secretary by 6 PM MT, February 8, 2012. Fees must accompany entries. Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their entry forms. Entry fees are non-refundable except for bitches coming into season after the closing date will be eligible for a refund up to 75% of total entry fee paid with a veterinarian's note. Checks will be deposited as soon as the show closes. A returned check will invalidate an entry and a \$40 service fee will be charged.

It is the responsibility of the owner or his/her agent to enter the appropriate class. The trial secretary will not automatically change entries to conform to AKC rules. Dogs may not move between regular and preferred classes once the trial has closed

Move ups to a higher class will occur from Friday to Saturday, Saturday to Sunday, and Sunday to Monday. A move-up book will be at the show site on Friday at the ribbon table. The request must be made to the Trial Secretary no later than 20 minutes after the last class ends each day. **No pre-show move-ups after noon February 27, 2012.**

The judging will start at 9 am on Friday and 8 am other days, except for ISC which will start at 7:30 am. During the hours of judging owners are to be on call and have their dogs ready to bring into the judging ring promptly in order that the judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for the judging of their class. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused.

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. **Any exhibitor entering this trial acknowledges that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all of the obstacles safely.**

Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. There will be no refund of entry fee for exhibitors that are asked to leave the show site because of their dog or children creating unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engaging in unsafe behavior. The Superstition Kennel Club and the Scottsdale Dog Fanciers Association may decline any entry for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Kennel Club or any official thereof.

Height Cards. All exhibitors with permanent (regular and preferred) measurements for their dog must indicate they have a permanent card on their entry or show it at check in. Dogs without permanent height cards will be measured at the show. This includes those jumping 24" and 26". Your confirmation will tell you whether or not there will be a permanent measuring judge at the show.

No glass containers are allowed on the property.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free from internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Arizona law requires rabies vaccine every 3 years.

WORKERS

We will need lots of volunteers to work at this trial. We understand that almost everyone will have conflicts, so we are going to schedule positions on a large grid that can be found at the volunteer tent. We know that people will most likely not know their schedules until they arrive so this allows for ultimate flexibility...in other words...you chose when you WANT to work. We have used this method very successfully at other shows! But we will need lots of workers, so PLEASE be sure to check the board and work where possible. Thank you in advance!

Each day there will be <i>FIESTA BUCKS</i> given to all workers. Workers receive script for each class they work and may use this toward future show entries offered by these clubs only.

Lunches will be provided for those who work at least two full classes per day.

A food vendor will be at the park on the days of our agility trials.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.**

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of Record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs enrolled in the **AKC Canine Partners Program** SM may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option effective April 1, 2010. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

I CERTIFY that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this agility trial, and by any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list for this agility trial, and further agree to be bound by the "Agreement" printed on the reverse side of this entry form. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. This entry is submitted for acceptance on the foregoing representation and agreement.
