CHECK-IN

IF you include a readable photocopy of your dog's NADAC card (for max height dogs) OR Permanent Jump Height Card, with your entry; you **will** be automatically checked in. This does **NOT** apply to dogs who need to be measured.

Saturday: Measure in will be between **7:15 and 7:45 am only**, for those who didn't sent in a copy of NADAC card / Permanent Jump Height Card OR dogs needing to be measured. **Measuring is not optional for dogs in the proficient category.** If a dog is required to be measured but is not measured, it is not eligible to run. Don't miss your check-in/measure-in time. Dogs running in Skilled need not be measured.

Important: During the trial please validate your dog's NADAC registration number on the posted copy of the results at the trial. Report any discrepancies to the trial secretary. **It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to verify their NADAC registration number.**

TENTATIVE RUNNING ORDER

Walk through and briefing will begin at **7:45 am**, Judging will begin at **8:00 am**

SATURDAY Small to Tall -- Regular 1, Regular 2 , Jumpers, Hoopers, and Tunnelers ~Elite, Open, Novice

- Running order is determined alphabetically. Handlers with more than one dog in a class will be separated if possible.
- All Exhibitors for a given class should be present at ringside at least one-half hour prior to the start of the scheduled classes for walk through and briefing.
- Any dog and handler not present when called will be ineligible to run.

MOVE-UPS

Move-ups or changes will be accept in writing only (or e-mail to ahammer9@cox.net) through February 19, 2010 at 6:00PM. **No changes will be accepted after this date.** This includes if there are any changes that need to be made because of incorrect entry on trial secretary's part. Please read your confirmations carefully prior to February 19th. There will be no move-ups during the trial.

REFUNDS

There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal.

A withdrawal from the competition after the closing date due to a bitch coming into season after the closing date will be eligible for a refund up to 75% of the total entry fee paid.

No entry fee refunded if the trial cannot open or completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire an act of God, public emergency and act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Exhibitors through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of the trial.

- Dogs must have valid NADAC registration numbers before entries will be accepted. The application for a NADAC registration number is available at www.nadac.com.

- Please double-check your entry form to ensure it is filled out completely and correctly. Entry may be returned if information that is critical to the entry is missing.
- We will provide electronic confirmations to all entrants who include their email addresses with their entry. If you included and email address, your confirmation will be sent as an attachment (PDF) in an email. **It is your responsibility to make sure ahammer9@cox.net is allowed by your spam blocker or to change options that strip attachment from emails.**
- Confirmation of entry will be sent to the address provided on the entry form (e-mail or snail mail) after closing date. **If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the confirmation within 3 days of the closing date, contact the Trial Secretary**
- Please review this confirmation carefully as there are NO MOVE UPS at this trial. If there are any changes that need to be made because of incorrect entry on trial secretary's part, you must notify Trial Secretary prior to **February 19th**. Corrections need not be made the day of the show.
- **Checks not honored by the bank DO NOT constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$35 service charge for bank returned checks.**
- All dogs must be on leash when not competing in the ring.
- No Alcoholic Beverages allowed on the show site.
- Rosettes/Coupons will be awarded to first through fourth places in all jump heights in all classes. Rosettes/Coupons awarded for those finishing a title and qualifying Rosettes/Coupons awarded for those achieving a qualifying score.
- The sponsoring club will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result is accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made
- Rubberized surfaces are used on all contact obstacles. Weave poles have 24" spacing. No shade or water is available at the site – please bring sufficient water for you and your dog(s).

We reserve the right to refuse entries

IMPORTANT. Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the files section of the NADACagility@yahoogroups.com list within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. The trial results will remain on the list for at least thirty (30) days. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the www.NADACagility@yahoogroups.com list and set your settings to "no mail". You will be able to view trial results and check for any possible discrepancies, without receiving list mail. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

Levels. Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be banked by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

This trial will be held under the current rules and regulations of NADAC with Jumping Chollas Agility Club as the sponsoring club. NADAC rules will prevail. Exhibitors through submission of entry acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations and agree to abide by all the rules in effect at the time of this trial. The trial committee has the right to refuse entry to anyone including anyone not in good standing with NADAC

DOGS MUST BE REGISTERED AND HAVE A VALID REGISTRATION NUMBER BEFORE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.

PROFICIENT / SKILLED CATEGORIES:

Each class will be split into two categories, Proficient and Skilled.

Skilled Category, dogs jump 4" lower than indicated by the current jump height table. (No dog can jump less than 4"). In all classes except Regular, a qualifying round must be clean. Dogs entered in the Skilled Category may incur 5 or fewer faults in regular agility, (course/time) and earn a 5 pt. qualifying round.

Proficient category a qualifying round must be clean with no courses faults and no time faults.

Jump Heights

Dogs entered in the Proficient Category must jump at the minimum jump height specified by the following table. Dogs entering the Skilled Category MUST jump one jump height lower than the heights listed in the table, although no dog shall jump lower than 4". All dogs must jump their valid jump height as determined by their Category and Division and may not jump higher.

As the table shows, there are five Standard Division-Proficient jump heights: 8", 12", 16", 20", 20+. There are four Standard Division-Skilled jump heights: 4", 8", 12", and 16". There are four jump heights for the Veterans and Junior Handler divisions: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

Veterans and Junior Handler dogs **must** jump their valid jump height and may not jump higher; thus, a Vets or JH dog may not jump higher than 16" in the Proficient category and no higher than 12" in the Skilled category.

There is no 4" Standard Division jump height in Proficient; the 4" Proficient height is for veteran dogs/handlers, disabled handlers, and junior handlers only. In the Skilled category, 8" dogs may jump 4" as their standard jump height. No dog may jump lower than 4".

SITE INFORMATION

This event will be held outdoors in a dirt arena with **no** shade. You will be responsible to provide shade for your dog(s). Parking and crating areas are available.

25200 N. 15th Ave., Phoenix ~~ from Happy Valley Rd. turn north onto 15th Ave., which is a dirt road. Please drive slowly and park inside the block walled area at the Cholla Patch. Parking and crating areas are available.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

- As used here "NADAC" means the North American Dog Agility Council, Inc., and their members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
- Exhibitor/owner agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- Exhibitor/owner certifies that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
- Exhibitor/owner release NADAC, (including their officers, directors, employees, and members), Jumping Chollas Agility Club (including its officers, agents, and employees), and owners of the Cholla Patch (including its officers, agents and employees), and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Exhibitor/owner hereby assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the afore-mentioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury, or death may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.
