### HANDLER DISCRIMINATION DIVISON



**Handler Discrimination** classes are titling classes in which the targeted scent is that of the handler themselves. Handlers are required to provide their own scented articles in a plastic bag. For the Novice class, one cotton glove or cotton sock, for Advanced, Excellent, and Master, cotton balls or cotton swabs. Three qualifying scores are required to earn titles in each class. Exhibitors may enter more than one dog in this class.

### DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete.

**Condition of the Dog.** Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Dogs with bandages, sutures, or visible wounds are not eligible. Deaf dogs and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Dogs that are both deaf and blind are able to participate so long as the handler is in control of the dog at all times, the dog can complete the requirements of the class, and the dog does not appear to be under undue stress in the opinion of the judge.

**Illegible entries** will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each invalid check.

**WAIT LIST INFORMATION**

JCACGP is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 25 entries will be placed on the club's wait list on order of receipt. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary by the listed closing date. No entries may be withdrawn for a refund after this date (except for BIS, or dogs pulled due to injury or illness, as per the "Refunds" provision on Page 6). If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait list entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry IF done prior to Wednesday, February 4th at 6:00 p.m. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial will receive a full refund.

Last day for any changes in the wait list is **Wednesday, February 4th at 6:00 p.m.**

**STAGING AREA, HANDLER'S BRIEFING, AND WARM-UP INFORMATION**

**Staging Area** will be out of view of search area(s). Staging area will include warm-up and waiting areas.

**Handler Briefings** – you may receive links to videos of your search areas the night before the trial. The judge will also give each exhibitor a short briefing when you come to each search area (no general briefing, and no class briefing before class starts).

One labelled container per target odor being used in the trial on that day will be placed in the warm-up area. This will allow handler-dog teams to prepare themselves for the search prior to their run. Each team should limit their warm-up to two minutes or less so that others may be able to use the warm-up area as well. Clubs may also place blank containers in the warm up area if they choose.

**SEARCH AREA AND RING CONDITIONS**

Search areas may be of any shape, and of the size specified in the Regulations for each class. Searches may be indoors, on matted, carpeted, or tiled surfaces, or outdoors on grass, gravel, earth, concrete, or asphalt surfaces. Trial will take place rain or shine.

Search area sizes will be as stated in the AKC regulations for all elements and levels.

**ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION**

**Trial Site.** It is not appropriate to scout the trial location prior to the trial date, this includes driving into the parking lot or otherwise disturbing their regular business. Many search locations are real-life environments, and such visits may risk the host losing the opportunity to use the location in the future. This trial site will not be used for Scent training one week before the trial.

**Possession of Odors and Training.** Chapter 5. Section 35 of the Scent Work Regulations states “No person other than those engaged in the administration of a trial shall be in possession of any target odor when on the trial grounds. There shall be no training on the grounds of the AKC Scent Work trial, other than the designated warm-up area”.

**Spectator Area.** Spectators are allowed except if judge deems that the space is too small and the presence will significantly affect the search area. Exhibitors are forbidden to discuss any details of the searches with handlers who have not run!

**Crating Space and Parking.** Please crate your dogs in your car. Please keep dogs quiet. If barking cannot be controlled you will be asked to leave. Keep dogs on leash while not working. **There is no parking for RVs.** No setups will be allowed. There will be no overnight security. **No overnight parking.**

**Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s).** Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

**RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES**

Placement ribbons will be awarded in each class as follows:

<i>First Place</i> .....	<i>Blue</i>
<i>Second Place</i> .....	<i>Red</i>
<i>Third Place</i> .....	<i>Yellow</i>
<i>Fourth Place</i> .....	<i>White</i>
<i>Qualifying Score</i> .....	<i>Dark Green</i>

A New Title rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title. You may pick up titling ribbons immediately upon completion. All other placement ribbons – more information will be included in your trial information.

**High in Trial** – High in Trial rosettes will be offered at this trial on Saturday and Sunday, within ½ hour of completion of trial each day. Only teams who participate in the same difficulty level in all elements offered (Container, Interior, and Buried), and qualify in each, are eligible to win High in Trial. There is no separate High In Trial for the Novice A and Novice B sections; they are combined. The High in Trial is determined by adding the team’s faults across the elements. If there is a tie based on faults, then the team’s times across the elements will be summed and the faster-finishing team will win. Teams winning High In Trial will earn a rosette.

**SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY**

The **safety of the dog** is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely. **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The **American Kennel Club** and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The **American Kennel Club** reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the **American Kennel Club** or any official thereof.

**Collars, Leashes and Harnesses.** During searches, dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge. A wearable camera such as a Go Pro may be mounted to the dog's harness, if desired. Leashes may be of any length and/or retractable. The leash should be made of plain, pliable material.

**All dogs must be on leash** at all times, and retractable leashes may not be used when on trial grounds (except during judged searches). Dogs must enter and exit the search area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting in the search area before and after the search. An off-leash option may be offered at the discretion of the judge, only if the area is completely enclosed.

**REFUNDS**

**No entry fee** will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. *However, the club reserves the right to alter this policy due to current events. If the trial is cancelled due to public health guidelines, you will receive a full refund.* **Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical condition/illness are eligible for a 75% refund.** The health and safety of your dog and all other dogs entered at the trial should be seriously respected.

**Bitches in season** will be refunded the full entry fee. **Notification in writing must be given to the trial secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial.**

**RINGSIDE**

**Judges are not required** to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the search area when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the search area when required.

**EXHIBITOR CHECK-IN:** At check-in you will receive your armband number.

**Exhibitors MUST check-in EACH day they are entered.**

**Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.**

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

**Judge's Steward** – Responsible for helping the judge throughout the trial. Usually, this position is filled by someone who is not running in the trial. Duties can include – handling "hot" items/ "cold" items, welcoming next competitor to search area, ensuring judge is comfortable and has water. Should be able to lift 35 lbs and stay on their feet for large portions of the day.

**Timer** – Uses stopwatch to time searches. Must be able to communicate clearly to judge and able to start/stop time accurately. Mostly stationary position.

**Box Steward** – Needed for Buried & Container searches. Will be bending, lifting up to 35 lbs, and rearranging/cleaning containers as needed.

**Gate Steward, Staging Area Steward** – Helps efficiently (and happily) move competitors through staging areas and into the search areas. These roles are important to running a smooth trial and for competitors to have a pleasant experience. Organization, clear communication, kindness.

**Scribe Sheet Runner** – Constantly moving throughout the trial, moving scribe sheets from the judge to the score room. Can be rotated with staging area stewards.
