4th Bi-annual Cactus Classic



The **Cactus Classic** will consist of 12 runs over two days. There will be an **Elite Division** and a **Pre-Elite Division**. Scoring will be cumulative across all 12 runs. All dogs will be running the same Elite level courses. All qualifying run(s) will receive Q's in Elite (even if they don't have an open title in that class)

Elite Division qualifications: Any dog with titles in all 3 NATCH classes at the Elite level (Elite Regular, Elite Chances, and Elite Jumpers).

Pre-Elite Qualifications: Must have a Novice title in both Regular and Weavers. In addition, they must have at least one Q in both Open Regular and Open Weavers.

How does it work: There will be 3 height divisions Small, Medium, & Large to help keep the competition fun & fair in both the elite division and the pre-elite division.

- Height divisions are based on the dog's wither heights noted on their premium. If a question of a dog's height occurs the dog will be measured at the event.
Small (dogs 14" & under) Medium (dogs over 14" up to & including 18") Large (dogs over 18")

Scoring for Classic and Team: All Saturday and Sunday runs start with a 150-point base. Time and course faults from each run will be subtracted from the base points. Eliminations, Scratches, & DNRs will receive a total score of zero for the run (Time 0 / Faults 150). The highest point total over all 12 runs wins.

Example: 150 points – 25 seconds to run course with 15 course faults = 110 points for that run.

Tiebreaker: In case of a points tie, time will be used to determine the winner. fastest combined time of Sat/Sun regular runs

Placements: Highest 3 scores win. First, Second, & Third place will be announced for each Height Division.

Cost: \$200 per dog (includes all 12 runs). Each HANDLER will receive an event shirt...not per dog entered. To guarantee you receive your event shirt on Friday of the event. Handlers must enter the event &/or purchase a shirt no later than Aug 31st

ADDED FUN EVENT – TEAM!!!

3-dog team can be any combination of level or height of dogs. There will not be a height division for the 3-dog team event only Pre-Elite & Elite.

If a team has 2 dogs enter in the Classic as Elite they are an Elite team. If they have 2 Pre-Elite dogs they are a Pre-Elite team.

1st, 2nd, & 3rd awards will be given to teams in both Elite & Pre-Elite.

3-Dog Team will have all 12 runs for all 3 dogs added together with the relay being worth 50% of the team's final score. Highest score winners.

3-Dog Relay starts with 2700 points with time and course fault subtracted.

The relay will have 3 numbered courses on the field. Each dog must run one of the courses. Failure to run all 3 courses will result in a E for the team. Normal course faults will be called. While running, handlers must run with a baton in a hand & pass it to the next handler. The next handler may not start running till they have the baton in their hand. Starting your run without the baton will result in an E. Additional info given at the event before we start running.

Handlers who enter the Classic or Team event MUST be present for the podium ceremony on Sunday. Failure to be there WILL result in being disqualified from the event

Refunds:

There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after one week before the show or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal.

A withdrawal from the competition due to a bitch coming into season after the closing date will be eligible for a refund up to 75% of the total entry fee paid.

No entry fee refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency and act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

There are four Standard Division-Proficient jump heights: 8", 12", 16", and 20".

There are four Standard Division-Skilled jump heights: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

There are four jump heights for the Veterans and Junior Handler divisions: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

Brief Summary of Rules:

Please refer to www.nadac.com for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

- Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.
- Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC or with JCAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted.

- A copy of the current Exhibitors Handbook may be downloaded free from the NADAC web site: www.nadac.com
- Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.
- No food, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within 10 feet of the ring. Food or a small non-audible toy can be in a secure container (Ziplock bag is acceptable) in your pocket during your run but it cannot be used during your run, nor can you indicate to the dog it is there. All handlers may bring a non-audible toy into the ring for training purposes. They cannot earn a Qualifying score and must declare to the judge they are training before they commence their run. Please read the Exhibitors Handbook for more information about toys and training in the ring.
- The sponsoring clubs will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result be accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

****Trial Code of Conduct****

JCAC trials are designed to be a fun, safe, and neutral environment, free from the everyday challenges and stresses of life. Handlers come to enjoy competing in agility with their dogs and fellow handlers. Playful banter, humor, and comical attire, as long as it's in good taste, are all acceptable at all JCAC trials.

However, unsportsmanlike behavior, including harassment of trial personnel or fellow competitors, and apparel or signage that includes hate speech, crude/vulgar language, strong political views, or anything else deemed in poor taste, will not be tolerated on trial grounds. Each case will be discussed by the Trial Committee members. If the Committee's findings result in a violation of the club's trial Code of Conduct, the person or people may be dismissed from the trial grounds. Depending on the severity of the violation, additional actions may be taken by JCAC and/or NADAC.

Also, late/day of handlers are **responsible** for talking to the Chief Ring Seward(s) to get your/dog's name on the scribe sheets & to talk to the Agility Gate Manager to get your/dog's name on Agility Gate. This needs to be done immediately after you have given your entry to the Trial Secretary.

Added Runs For Dog(s) Already Entered: We love that you are having so much fun and want to add runs. **A \$10/dog fee will be added to the \$16/run fee for adding runs day of.** You Must add those runs before the course has been set/numbered. The sooner the better please/thanks. It's also the handlers **responsible** for talking to the Chief Ring Seward(s) to get your/dog's name on the scribe sheets & to talk to the Agility Gate Manager to get your/dog's name on Agility Gate for those added runs. This needs to be done immediately after you have given your entry to the Trial Secretary. Keep in mind the CRS & AGM might be running dogs so, catch them when you can if that's the case.

1.2. Exhibitor/owner agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.

1.3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.

1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the surface, restrooms, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.

1.5. Exhibitor/owner releases NADAC (including its respective officers, directors, employees, and members) and Jumping Chollas Agility Club (including its officers, directors, members, and event organizing committee) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. 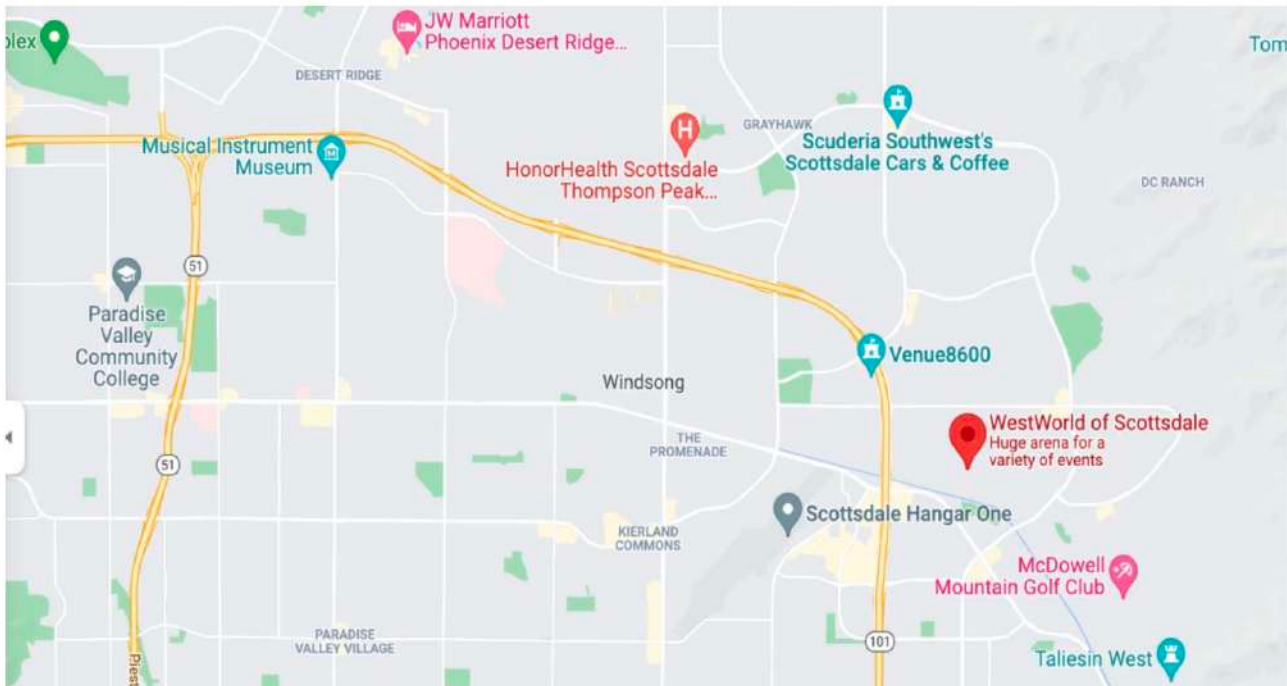
- Bahia loop will lead straight to the entrance gate by covered 5A Arena.

Go South on Bahia Loop to entrance gate by covered 5A Arena.

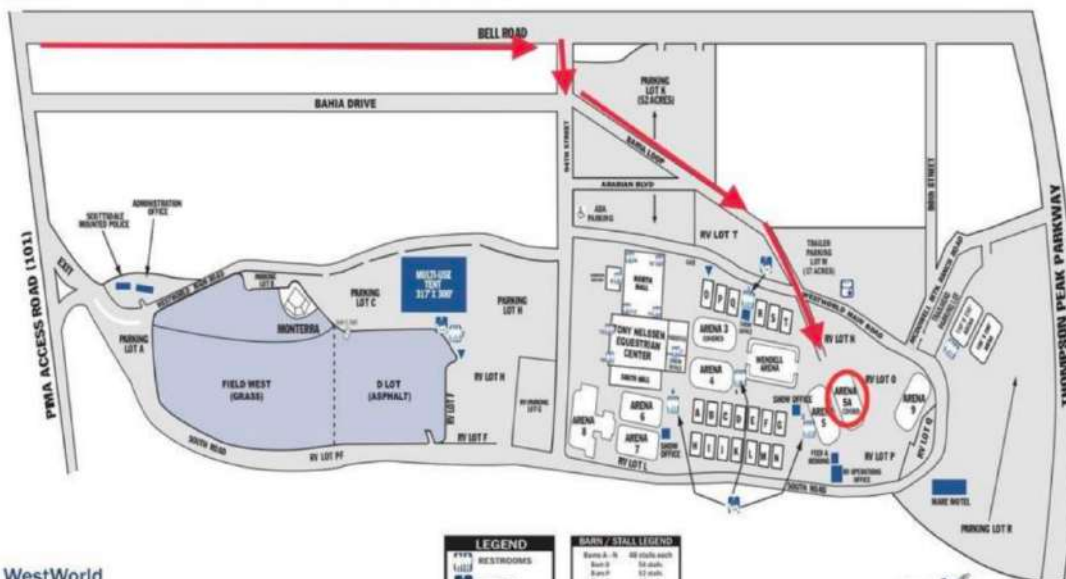
