Refunds:

There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after one week before the show or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal.

A withdrawal from the competition after one week before the show due to a bitch coming into season after the closing date will be eligible for a refund up to 75% of the total entry fee paid.

No entry fee refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency and act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

JUMP HEIGHTS

There are four Standard Division-Proficient jump heights: 8", 12", 16", and 20".

There are four Standard Division-Skilled jump heights: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

There are four jump heights for the Veterans and Junior Handler divisions: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

Brief Summary of Rules:

Please refer to www.nadac.com for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

- Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.
- Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. New Handlers please register here: [NADAC-New Handler-Dog Registration](#). If you already have a dog registered with NADAC or are a NADAC Associate, please visit the H&D Portal to register a new dog.
- A copy of the current Exhibitors Handbook may be downloaded free from the NADAC web site: www.nadac.com
- Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.
- No food, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within 10 feet of the ring. Food or a small non-audible toy can be in a secure container (zip-lock bag is acceptable) in your pocket during your run but you cannot indicate to the dog it is there. All handlers may bring a non-audible toy into the ring for training purposes. They cannot earn a Qualifying score and must declare to the judge they are training before they commence their run. Please read the Exhibitor's Handbook for more information about toys and training in the ring.
- The sponsoring clubs will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result be accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

****Trial Code of Conduct****

JCAC trials are meant to be a fun, safe, neutral place away from everyday challenges and stresses. Handlers come to enjoy competing in agility with their dogs and fellow handlers. Playful banter/humor along with comical attire and visible signage (e.g., shirts, jackets, banners) in good taste is acceptable at all JCAC trials.

No branding or messaging about social issues, politics, or religion is allowed within the confines of JCAC shows. Conversations leading to arguments or obvious discomfort among exhibitors are not acceptable at JCAC trials and will result in dismissal from the trial without refund. All unsportsmanlike conduct, including harassing trial officials and/or fellow handlers, will also result in dismissal from the trial without refund.

All issues will be discussed by the Show Committee on a case-by-case basis with a final decision determined. Those handlers dismissed from the trial will be noted in the show report to NADAC.

Late & Day of Show Entries: All late/day of entries **MUST** be given to the Trial Secretary & paid in full **NO** later than 30 minutes before the 1st dog on the line time posted on the 1st page of premium. No new entries will be taken after that time or if payment is not given at time of entry. Also, late/day of handlers are **responsible** for talking to the Chief Ring Seward(s) to get your/dog's name on the scribe sheets & to talk to the Agility Gate Manager to get your/dog's name on Agility Gate. This needs to be done immediately after you have given your entry to the Trial Secretary.

Added Runs For Dog(s) Already Entered: We love that you are having so much fun and want to add runs. **A \$10/dog fee will be added to the \$14/run fee for adding runs day of.** You must add those runs before the course has been set/numbered. The sooner the better please/thanks. It's also the handler's **responsibility** for talking to the Chief Ring Seward(s) to get your/dog's name on the scribe sheets & to talk to the Agility Gate Manager to get your/dog's name on Agility Gate for those added runs. This needs to be done immediately after you have given your entry to the Trial Secretary. Keep in mind the CRS & AGM might be running dogs so, catch them when you can if that's the case.

AGREEMENT

1.1. As used here "NADAC" means the North American Dog Agility Council, LLC., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.

1.2. Exhibitor/owner agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.

1.3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is currently in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.

1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the surface, restrooms, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.

1.5. Exhibitor/owner releases NADAC (including its respective officers, directors, employees, and members) and Jumping Chollas Agility Club (including its officers, directors, members, and event organizing committee) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assumes sole responsibility for and agrees to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons

SPECIAL EVENTS!!!!

Triathlon and Biathlon

Triathlon: Consists of Saturday's Round 1 Weavers & Round 1 Tunnelers and Sunday's Round 1 Touch N Go.

- Dogs will be placed in the division in which they run Weavers. Example: Dog is in Open Weavers but Elite Touch N Go and Tunnelers. The dog will be placed in the Open Triathlon Division.

Biathlon: Consists of Sunday's Round 1 Regular and Round 1 Tunnelers.

- Dogs will be placed in the division in which they run Regular. Example: Dog is in Open Regular but Elite Tunnelers. The dog will be placed in the Open Biathlon Division.

Levels: Dogs will compete in one of three levels as described above: Novice, Open, or Elite

Height Divisions for Triathlon and Biathlon:

- Height divisions are based on the dog's withers height. If a question of a dog's height occurs the dog will be measured at the event.
 - Small (dogs 14" and under)
 - Medium (dogs over 14" up to and including 18")
 - Large (dogs over 18")

Scoring: Scoring will be time plus faults, subtracted from 150 base points per run. DNRs and eliminations are scored as 0 points for that run.

- Example: Base points: 150 points
 Dog's run time: - 30 seconds
 Faults: - 10 faults
 Dog's score for that run: 110 points

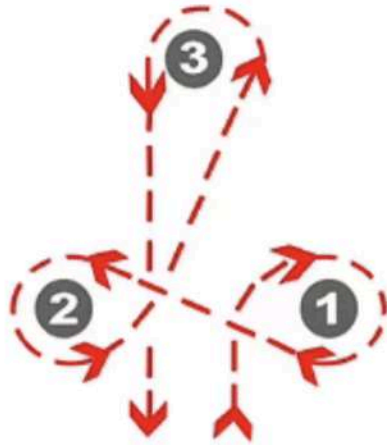
Podium Placement: 1st, 2nd and 3rd will be placed in each level/height division.

Awards/Prizes: We will have a podium and will announce the winners of each event. Special awards/prizes will be given to each who podiumed.

Cost: \$10 per dog per event plus standard run fees.

SPECIAL EVENTS!!!!

K9 Barrel Rush



Cost: \$10 per dog

How it Works: Each dog entered will get 2 runs around the pattern shown above for time.

Mulligan Run: If you had a bad run or just want to try & get a faster time, you can pay \$5 (cash/check) to the Trial Secretary. You can only get 1 Mulligan Run per dog entered.

Height Divisions:

- Height divisions are based on the dog's wither height. If a question of a dog's height occurs the dog will be measured at the event.
 - **Small** (dogs 14" and under)
 - **Medium** (dogs over 14" up to & including 18")
 - **Large** (dogs over 18")

Scoring: Dogs 2 fastest times will be combined. Lowest combined time wins.

Tiebreaker: Dog with the fastest single run wins.

Prize: Winner takes all \$\$\$ in each Height Division
