Entry Limits:

This trial is limited to 200 total runs

Move ups:

Move-ups, changes, or corrections will be accepted by e-mail to skoffagility@gmail.com by July 8, 2025. Please read your confirmations carefully.

Day of Show / Late Entries:

Late entries will only be accepted if the show is not full. There is a flat \$10 late fee for each dog entered late. No day of show entries, whether or not the show is full. Please read JCAC Full Trial Etiquette attached to this premium.

Refunds:

There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after one week before the show or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal.

A withdrawal from the competition after one week before the show due to a bitch coming into season after the closing date will be eligible for a refund up to 75% of the total entry fee paid.

No entry fee refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency and act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Dogs cannot be officially measured before 2 years old but must be measured by the time they are competing in Elite.

JUMP HEIGHTS

There are four Standard Division-Proficient jump heights: 8", 12", 16", and 20".

There are four Standard Division-Skilled jump heights: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

There are four jump heights for the Veterans and Junior Handler divisions: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

Brief Summary of Rules:

Please refer to www.nadac.com for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

- Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.
- Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil
 disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause
 beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. https://www.nadac.com/register-your-dog/
- A copy of the current Exhibitors Handbook may be downloaded free from the NADAC web site: www.nadac.com
- Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.
- No food, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within 10 feet of the ring. Food or a small non-audible toy can be in a secure container (ziplock bag is acceptable) in your pocket during your run but it cannot be used during your run, nor can you indicate to the dog it is there. All handlers may bring a non-audible toy into the ring for training purposes. They cannot earn a Qualifying score and must declare to the judge they are training before they commence their run. Please read the Exhibitors Handbook for more information about toys and training in the ring.
- The sponsoring clubs will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result be accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

- No coupons can be used with this online option. However, you can still get junior handler pricing through this online entry.
- Emailed entries to the show secretary will only be accepted from trial workers/committee members who have a free entry for their dog(s). Payment for their additional dogs must come immediately please.
- Failure to pay required fees will exclude the exhibitor from future Jumping Chollas shows
- Note that a PayPal refund, if allowed, will be 90% of the original payment due to the fees charged by PayPal.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

- 1.1. As used here "NADAC" means the North American Dog Agility Council, LLC., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
- 1.2. Exhibitor/owner agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- 1.3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- 1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the surface, restrooms, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
- 1.5. Exhibitor/owner releases NADAC (including its respective officers, directors, employees, and members) and Jumping Chollas Agility Club (including its officers, directors, members, and event organizing committee) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assumes sole responsibility for and agrees to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons

Run Pricing Information

All classes for adult handlers \$13/run.

Junior Handlers - \$7/run.

No more than 50% of trial fees can come from coupons/Jumping Bucks. Late fee \$10 per dog if received after July 8, 2025.

If you have never done NADAC before, or it has been over 3 years since you have done NADAC, we are offering a welcome to the venue deal where you can enter all classes each day for 50% OFF your entry. It is only valid for your first time at a NADAC trial as the handler for those that haven't done NADAC in over 3 years. New dogs under a handler who has done NADAC before are not eligible.

SITE INFORMATION



This event will be held outdoors on artificial turf surface with <u>no</u> shade or water. You will need to provide shade and water for your dog(s). Note that NOTHING can be staked on the turf!

25128 N. 15th Ave., Phoenix. From Happy Valley Rd. turn north onto 15th Ave. Please drive slowly and park *inside* the block walled area at the Cholla Patch, or you may park along the NORTH wall outside of the facility. No parking is permitted along 15th Ave.

Jumping Chollas Agility Club is not responsible for lost or stolen dogs or equipment.

JCAC Full Trial Etiquette

If a trial is declared full, it is because we have reached the maximum number of runs as stated on the premium for that day. That number of runs was determined based on experience, taking into account the type of classes offered and the amount of time/daylight we have available.

When the maximum is reached, the trial secretary starts a wait list for each day and maintains it through the show dates. To be on the waitlist, entry and fees need to be received by the trial secretary (to be clear – you cannot have a place reserved in the show until payment is received).

The club pays NADAC and the judge for every run that's on the books at the beginning of the trial, and when we are using Agility Gate, the files are finalized 2-3 days before the trial begins. If the trial has reached the maximum number of runs for a specific day, the trial secretary is not allowed to add runs to dogs already entered or to add dogs to the show. IT IS FULL!

Even if someone scratches, those runs are not "up for grabs," they are still on the books and count toward the maximum. If someone pulls out of the show ahead of time and there are runs available, it is the responsibility of the trial secretary to fill those runs from the waitlist, in order, not from whoever is handy. If someone scratches on the day of the show, those runs are not available AT ALL.

The trial secretaries are following the policies of NADAC and JCAC with regard to the number of runs at trials and are acting to be fair to all exhibitors. Please be considerate, we are doing our job as well as we possibly can.
