You can use Agility Gate to check-in your dog & scratch your dog if needed. Only the person running agility gate can move your dog if there is a conflict. **The Agility Gate Code is 1818.**

Exhibitors have the option of entering a mixture of Regular classes and Preferred classes. To do so they must submit two separate entry forms; one for Regular classes and one for Preferred classes.

The regular Novice classes are divided into Divisions A and B. Division A is for dogs that have never acquired any AKC Agility title. Additionally, a dog entered in Novice A must be handled by a person that has never put an AKC Agility title on any dog, and the handler must be the Owner, Co-Owner, or a member of the Owner's household. Handlers that co-own a dog and have never put an AKC Agility title on a dog may enter the Novice A class regardless of the other co-owner's AKC Agility accomplishments. Dogs eligible for Novice A may be entered in the Novice B class at the discretion of the Owner.

Division B is for dogs that have acquired the Novice Agility title or the Novice Jumpers with Weaves (NAJ) title, or for persons who have handled a dog to any AKC Agility title, and for dogs being handled by someone other than the Owner, Co-Owner, or household member subject to the restrictions listed above. A dog may continue to be shown in the Novice B Class until they have acquired a qualifying score towards their Open Agility (OA) title.

Preferred Standard

Novice Preferred Standard (NAP), Open Preferred Standard (OAP), Excellent "A" Preferred Standard (AXP), Excellent "B" Preferred Standard (MXP)

Preferred JWW

Novice Preferred JWW (NJP), Open Preferred JWW (OJP), Excellent "A" Preferred JWW (AJP), Excellent "B" JWW (MJP)

Preferred FAST

Novice Preferred FAST (NFP), Open Preferred FAST (OFP), Excellent "A" Preferred FAST (AFP), Excellent "B" Preferred FAST (MFP)

All dogs entered in the Preferred Classes for the first time must enter the Novice level in both the Preferred Agility Class and the Preferred Jumpers with Weaves Class regardless of their previous title level in the Regular Classes (Standard & JWW). There is no grandfathering of titles from the Regular Classes to the Preferred Classes or from the Preferred Classes to the Regular Classes. The classes are separate titling programs and in both cases the dog must start at the Novice level.

Preferred (NAP) or Open Agility Preferred (OAP) titles but which have not acquired the Agility Excellent Preferred (AXP) title. Exhibitors have the option of entering EITHER the Preferred classes OR the Regular classes. Exhibitors may not mix Preferred and regular classes at any set of trials.

Ring Information

This trial will be held in 2 rings at least 100 feet by 100 feet in diameter. Classes will be running in both rings with 2 judges. It will be held outside on grass, regardless of the weather. There is not much shade in the event area, but plenty of room for shade tents.

Awards

Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores. First through Fourth place Rossette will be awarded in each class for each height division for qualifying scores. For a Double Q in Masters and Masters Preferred; Standard and JWW you have a choice of a Rosette or a QQ Pin. Beautiful poles and Rossette will also be awarded to those who earn a MACH, PACH or PAX. We will also offer Rosettes for new title(s). You also have a choice of coupons towards your entry of future JCACGP AKC trial if you do not want to take a ribbon/rosette/pin.

All awards must be collected during the show. None will be held over or mailed. Awards will not be available until the judge has reviewed the appropriate scribe sheets. We will be using NCR sheets.

Height Divisions

There will NOT be a VMO to measure dogs at this show.

Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog needs to be officially measured. Please check the box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs To Be Measured List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 24C height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present; ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

Warm-Ups

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. The walk-through allows handlers to plan their strategy for running the course. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class.

There will be no course familiarization for Novice handlers at this trial.

A warm-up area, consisting of one regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors. Exhibitors may **NOT** use the warm-up area to relieve their dogs.

Eligibility Of Dogs

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word “dog” is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog’s physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under 4 months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

Exhibitor Information

The trial will be conducted under American Kennel Club **Regulations for Agility Trials**. Entries must reach the Trial Secretary by 6 PM (Arizona time), Saturday, October 11, 2025. Fees must accompany entries. Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their entry forms. **Entry fees are non-refundable except for bitches coming into season after the closing date.** Females in season will be fully refunded if withdrawn by the Trial Secretary after closing and no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial. Checks will be deposited once the show closes. A returned check will invalidate an entry and a \$25 service fee will be charged.

It is the responsibility of the owner or his/her handler to enter the appropriate class. The trial secretary will not automatically change entries to conform to AKC rules. Dogs may not move between regular and preferred classes once the trial has closed.

There will be move-ups each day. Forms will be available at the trial and must be completed by 3 pm the preceding day.

Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not permitted to use whistles or other instruments or devices in or around the course area.

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary no later than 6 PM (Arizona time) Saturday, October 11, 2025.

The judging will start promptly. During the hours of judging owners are to be on call and have their dogs ready to bring into the judging ring promptly in order that the judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for the judging of their class. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused.

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. Any exhibitor entering this trial acknowledges that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all of the obstacles safely.

Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. There will be no refund of entry fee for exhibitors that are asked to leave the show site because of their dog or children creating unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engaging in unsafe behavior.

Height Cards. All exhibitors without permanent (regular and preferred) measurements for their dog must indicate on their entry that they do NOT have a permanent card. Dogs without permanent height cards will be measured at the show by a VMO or Judge. This includes those jumping 24” and 26”. Your confirmation will tell you whether there will be a permanent measuring judge at the show.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians’ recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccination

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, **prior to running**. If measured by the Judge of Record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs enrolled in the **AKC Canine Partners Program** SM may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option effective April 1, 2010. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____

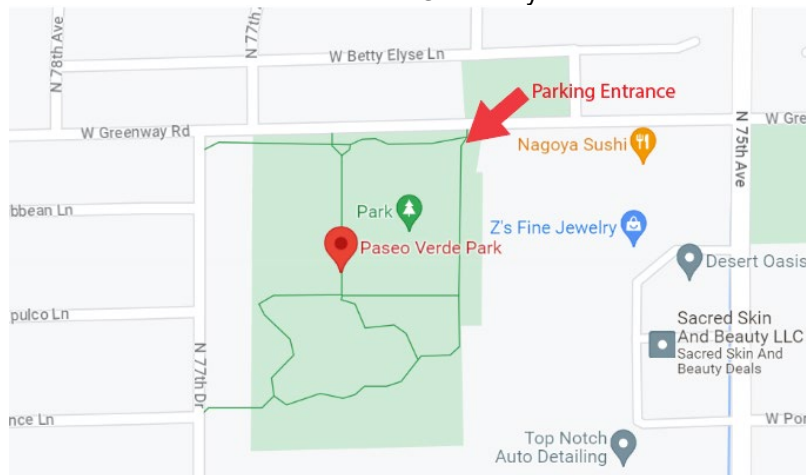

Setup & Security
