## Is your Team Ready?



Are you ready to enter an agility show? Answering the questions below will help you decide.

1. Does your dog focus well while it's working?
2. Can your dog weave 6 poles comfortably?
(Ifyour dog is not weaving, no problem. You can still enter events without weaves, such as Jumpers, Tunnelers, Hoopers, Touch n' Go, \& Barrelers).
3. Is your dog performing consistent contact behavior?
(If not, there are other classes you can enter your dog in such as Jumpers, Tunnelers, Hoopers, Weavers \& Barrelers).
4. Will your dog stay with you and not visit others in the ring?
5. Is your dog comfortable with other dogs watching?
6. Entering a show/trial is your decision. Are you ready?
7. If it feels like you're ready, here are the class options (and obstacles):
※ Jumpers (jumps \& tunnels)
$\approx$ Chances (everything with a distance challenge)
$\approx$ Regular (everything)
\% Tunnelers (all tunnels)
\% Touch \& Go (contacts, tunnels \& hoops)
\% Weavers (weaves, hoops, tunnels)
\% Barrelers (barrels, hoops, tunnels)
$\approx$ Hoopers (all hoops)
\% Gamblers (novice only, all equipment)
There are no teeters, tires or tables in NADAC.
